

# Final Grade Checking & Objection in Fall 2022

Final grade checking(notification) & Objection period in Fall semester 2022 is as below,

## I. Main Issue & Schedule

1. Period for Final grade checking & Objection: **12.16. (Fri) 10:00 ~ 12.21(Mon) 23:00**

2. If one or more of the followings are applied, the final grade checking & objection are not available within the period.

**First, in case of ‘having NOT participated in all Course Evaluation’ (the evaluation must be completed for all courses you registered):**

Students can check their final grade & file objection after finishing the course evaluation on the last day only.

**Second, in case of ‘having NOT completed compulsory education:**

· In case of ‘having NOT completed violence prevention (legally required) education (Starting from the 2022.2 semester)’:

Undergraduate students can check grades within the public notice period after completing all legally required education, such as sexual violence, domestic violence, and disability awareness improvement. (Students can check their grades on the next day after they complete the education.)

· In case of ‘having NOT completed safety education’(for students required to take safety education):

Students can check their final grade after they complete safety education within the final grade checking period.

· In case of international students having not completed ‘The Introduction of K-Law’ and ‘Sexual Violence Preventive Education’ (Starting from 2022. 1st semester):

International students can check their final grades after they complete all the education required within the final grade checking period. (Students can check their grades on the next day after they complete the education.)

## III. Notes

- Filing objection about final grades not based on evaluation standards, but based on other reasons (exchange students selection, double-major application, scholarship, graduation, etc) can be improper solicitation, so please keep that in mind.
