

[COVID-19] SKKU Campus Guidelines

- ※ Campus restriction not only means not allowed on campus, but also to refrain from making contacts both in and out of campus. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, please take a Rapid Antigen test or PCR test.
- ※ If you are a faculty or staff member, follow the above guidelines, but in the event of any unusual occurrences, please notify the campus emergency committee through the university administration office.
- ※ If you log into Kingo-M system, an automatic message will be delivered to faculty. But, please be sure to notify the faculty of your designated class.
- ※ If you still have health symptoms even if your Rapid antigen test or PCR test result is negative, you should submit related health document for verification of attendance.

You	Confirmed case of COVID-19 (RAT or PCR) (Positive result)	<p>① Do not come to campus & Home treatment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">→ When tested positive, enter the information directly in Kingo M system→ Notify the confirmed case to nearby contacts <p>② Health Counseling in Health Center</p> <p>③ 7 day self-quarantine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">→ In confirmed case of COVID-19(RAT or PCR), you should submit related health documents for verification of attendance via e-mail(medical attachments or diagnosis) to the faculty (7 days) <ul style="list-style-type: none">※ When self-diagnostic kit is positive, <u>quarantine authorities Rapid Antigen test or PCR test is required</u>※ When someone with a confirmed case enters the dormitory after treatment:<ul style="list-style-type: none">→ No clinical symptoms & After 7 day self-quarantine→ Can enter the dormitory

	When waiting for the result of a COVID-19 test (RAT or PCR)	<p>① Do not come to campus & Self-quarantine</p> <p>② In case of self-quarantine, you should submit related health documents for verification of attendance via e-mail (medical attachments or diagnosis) to the faculty</p> <p>③ Tested Negative → Allowed to come to campus</p>
House mate & Family	Confirmed case of COVID-19 (RAT or PCR) (Positive result)	<p>① Allowed to come to campus, but you are required to take RAT or PCR test before coming to campus.</p> <p>you should submit related health documents for verification of attendance via e-mail (medical attachments or diagnosis) to the faculty if you need to.</p> <p>(Regardless of whether or not vaccinated)</p> <p>※ 10-day manual monitoring; It is recommended to refrain from visiting multi-use facilities or taking off masks in campus</p>
	When waiting for the result of a COVID-19 test (RAT or PCR)	<p>① Allowed to come to campus</p> <p>(Regardless of whether or not vaccinated)</p> <p>※ 10-day manual monitoring; It is recommended to refrain from visiting multi-use facilities or taking off masks in campus</p>

■ Cases & Recommended period for wearing masks

Case	Recommended period for wearing masks
Symptomatic	Until symptoms persist
High-risk group (over 60 years, immunosuppressed, underlying disease)	if applicable
Contacts of Symptomatic or High-risk group	while in contact
Contacts of the confirmed case	2 weeks from the date of contact
