

EXPECTATIONS

<u>Please note:</u> A significant portion of our patient population speaks Korean, and, if necessary, patient encounters may be translated to English by the physician or a dedicated translator

- Jaseng Hospital of Korean Medicine specializes in non-surgical treatments within the realm of Korean Medicine. Predominantly employing Integrative Medicine, our treatments involve acupuncture, pharmacopuncture, herbal medicine, Chuna manual therapy, and more. We integrate allopathic diagnostic methods such as MRIs, X-rays, and pathological examinations.
- Participants in our program will have the opportunity to observe patients undergoing various treatments, particularly in areas such as traffic injuries, whiplash, herniated discs, dislocations, fractures, pain management, Bell's palsy, disease prevention, and more.
- As this program is situated in Korea, participants will gain firsthand experience and global insights into the Korean hospital healthcare system and operations. Additionally, they will visit our affiliated universities and hospitals.
- Participants will have the opportunity to learn and participate in research conducted at Jaseng. They will learn about research methodology and evidence-based medicine. Despite common misconceptions about Integrative Medicine lacking scientific evidence, participants in our program will be exposed to research supporting these treatments. Visits to our research laboratory and herbal dispensaries are also included in the program.

Participants will have the opportunity to learn and broaden their spectrum of medicine, which will undoubtedly contribute to their future practice.

Application Process

Step 1 Sign up:

Make a user account on our website

Step 2 Select:

View our rage of medical programs and select the type of program and the date that is right for you

Step 3 Apply:

Prepare all the documents listed on the Application from and apply for the program from our website

Step 4 Confirm:

Once you have applied for the program our staff will review your application and be in contact with you to schedule a Zoom Meeting

Step 5 Enroll:

Once we have a Zoom meeting with you and confirmed proceed to the enrollment process

Step 6 Prepare:

Book your flights, accommodation and visa. Prepare for your rotation and visit to South Korea

Step 7 Rotate:

Start your Integrative medicine journey at Jaseng Hospital of Korean Medicine

Additional Information

- 1. MEALS: Lunch is provided Monday-Friday
- 2. FLIGHTS: Flights are not organized or provided by us
- 3. ACCOMODATION: It is not provided by the academy either; however, we offer a recommended list of hotels around the hospital on our site
- 4. VISA APPLICATION: Once accepted to the program we will provide you with a visa invitation letter on request, which is required to secure your visa.
- 5. INSURANCE: Students must purchase their own individual travel insurance for their full duration in South Korea

- 6. ATTIRE : Students are required to be dressed smart casual during the program
 - 1) Closed shoes must be worn at all times (no flip flops, sandals)
 - 2) No loungewear (sweatshirts/pants, yoga or athletic wear, pajamas)
 - 3) No revealing clothing
- 7. LAB COAT : Customized white coats with intern's name on them are provided for the duration of the program
- 8. CERTIFICATION: A Certificate is rewarded in completion of the activity
- 9. REFUND POLICY: As all our programs are converted to pay ones, we made the refund policy in case of expelling and drop out. It is on the website at the end of online application in CONSENT FORM

REFUND POLICY

[Full Refund Eligibility]

To be eligible for a full refund, you must submit a cancellation request via email at least 28 days prior to the start date of the program.

[Partial Refund Eligibility]

If a cancellation request is received with less than 28 days' notice but before the program commencement, you are eligible for a 50% refund.

[Non-Refundable Situations]

No shows or requests received after the program has commenced are not eligible for a refund.

[Participant Conduct and Expulsion]

Participants may be expelled from the program after receiving one warning due to misconduct or failure to abide by Jaseng Hospital's rules and regulations. Expelled participants are not eligible for a refund.

[Refund Process]


