Visa Extension

1. Students in overseas

In case entry is not possible within the expired date on the back of ARC (e.g. March 31)

- Need to issue a new Certificate of Admission
- The required documents: Refer to the Q&A (Last page)
- Re-issue ARC after arrival
- Apply after expiry date of ARC

2. Students in Korea

If the stay period remains on ARC → Extensions are possible and must be extended

※ Visa problem if you cancel your leave of absence

- OISS will notice students who have not passed expiry date of ARC
- Cannot entry before the process is completed, OISS will notice availability of entry after completion of processing

Application of Alien Registration Card

1. According to the Immigration Control Act, foreigners have to do the alien registration within 90 days of arrival (regardless the date of new semester starts)
2. If fail to do the alien registration after entering South Korea, you will have to apply for new visa again.

※ In case you absent in South Korea after applying visa

Survey will be taken. You must respond to the survey, otherwise there will be a problem with your visa.



[Q&A]

Q. Currently, I am unable to leave my home country. What should I do now?

A. As we will continue to have online class until the current situation (Covid-19) being controlled, so students are not necessary to enter South Korea now. However, in case you are a visa holder, the visa will be cancelled as well from the expired date. If you wish to enter South Korea, you have to get a new Certificate of Admission and apply for a new visa.

Q. Is there any problem if I listen to lectures with the expired visa? Will I be expelled?

A. Once you have done the registration, you will not be expelled. Even though your visa is expired, you still can listen to the lectures, just you may face a problem to enter or leave South Korea. However, If you have to attend offline lectures or sit for offline exams, you must apply a new visa again using a new Certificate of Admission.

Q. Do I have to be in South Korea to extend my visa?

A. Yes. To extend your visa, the immigration office will need to confirm your presence in South Korea.

Q. I want to make a new visa as my previous visa is expired.

A. For students who have their visa expired, you need to apply for a new visa.
